Eligibility:

1. The applicant must be an active, registered student in one of the following counties: Nueces, Jim Wells, San Patricio, Refugio and Victoria counties.
2. The applicant must be a graduating senior of the 2025-2026 school year and provide the most recent copy of his/her high school transcript.
3. The applicant must have participated in an athletic activity during the 2025-2026 school year (athlete, trainer, volunteer coach) and performed community service related to school/community.

Requirements:

1. The applicant must submit a Letter of Acceptance from the college, university, or trade/technical school he/she/ will be attending in the Fall 2026 semester. The scholarship is to be used in the Fall 2026 after which it will no longer be disbursed.
2. Sections 1-3 of Part II are to be completed in typed resume format.
3. Once announced, winner must provide a portrait style/headshot photograph (senior cap and gown preferred) no larger than 4 x 6 inches to be displayed in the business booth for 1 year.
4. One letter of recommendation from the following:
 - A high school principal, assistant principal, counselor, coach, teacher, or an organization where he/she has volunteered. (non-family member)

Letters should be typed, signed, and must have the name, title, address, and phone number of the writer. Each letter should be submitted in a sealed envelope.

Submission of the Application: We request all applications be dropped off at JP Sports Collectibles located at the Corpus Christi Trade Center by 4:00 pm on May 10, 2026.
